## Executive Summary

- 2017 was a very successful year for the project ICYUZUZO, with a total of 101 children finishing the school year with us. The project made a tremendous impact on the school results of the children, uplifting the overall grade across all classes from $65 \%$ in the $1^{\text {st }}$ term to $76 \%$ in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ term, representing an uplift of $17 \%$ !
- Furthermore $88 \%$ of children increased their grades this year (Term 117 vs Term 3 2017), an increase from 2016 where this was @83\%. This is a testament to the hard work of our teachers who work tirelessly to ensure that no child is left behind.


## Key highlights for 2017:

- 8 children more than doubled their grades in 2017!
- One child went from $31 \%$ to $81 \%$
- Another child went from $34 \%$ to $74 \%$
- 3 children went from having grades in the $20 \%$ s to achieving in the $60 \%$ s
- The number of kids who had less than $50 \%$ went from 15 kids down to only 4 kids!
- The number of kids who had $90 \%+$ doubled - went from 8 up to 16
- The number of kids who had $80 \%+$ went from 22 up to 48


## 88\% of all pupils increased their grades in 2017

Improvement Term of Term of the average class grade


- $88 \%$ of all the pupils increased their grades in 2017
- There is a steady increase in the average grade of each class Term on Term and comparing Term 1 and $3^{\text {rd }}$ term; there is :
- $29 \%$ uplift for Year 2 average grade
- $16 \%$ uplift for Year 3 average grade
- $11 \%$ uplift for Year 4 average grade
- $16 \%$ uplift for Year 5 average grade


# 2 Years on - ICYUZUZO making a huge impact! 



## Dukunduwera Vivine (Year 4)- one grade away from the perfect score!

Started with the project in 2016 in Year 3 and continued into Year 4 in 2017. She started with $60 \%$ in the 1stTerm 2016 and ended the year @85\% in $3^{r d}$ term2016an uplift of $43 \%$ !
In 2017 she continued on her path to excellence and started Year 4 with 81\% in $1^{\text {st }}$ term and by the $3^{\text {rd }}$ Term had achieved a phenomenal 99\%!


## Iradukunda Sandrine (Year 4)

- Has seen tremendous progress since joining ICYUZUZO in 2016 in Year3.

Iradukunda has been greatly impacted by the project, taking her from an average student @64\% in $1^{\text {st }}$ term 2016 to 93\% in $3^{\text {rd }}$ term 2016 and top of her class. In 2017 she continues to perform excellently and she was top of her class in $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ terms.

## Year 2 highlights

- 5 pupils more than doubled their grades T1 vs T3

Improvement in grades Term on Term


- In the first term, 6 pupils had less than $50 \%$ grade, by the $3^{\text {rd }}$ term this was down to 1 pupil
- By $3^{\text {rd }}$ Term, the number of pupils who had
- $70 \%+$ had risen from 9 to 14
- $80 \%+$ doubled from 6 to 12
- $90 \%+$ doubled from 4 to 8
- The average grade of Year 2 saw a steady increase:
- 61.21\% in T1
- 74.74\% in T2
- 79.21\% in T3


## Star performers

- Niyogisubizo Pacifique, almost tripled his grades from $24 \%$ in the first grade to 67\% in the third!
- Manishimwe Cedric went from having 31\% grade in T1 2017 to achieving 81\% grade in T3 2017. He went from being $32^{\text {nd }}$ in his class to being in the top ten of his class ( $9^{\text {th }}$ )


## Year 3 highlights

Improvement in grades Term on Term


- In the first term, 3 pupils had less than $50 \%$ grade, by the $3^{\text {rd }}$ term this was down to 1 pupil
- By $3^{\text {rd }}$ Term, the number of pupils who had
- $70 \%+$ had risen from 12 to 17
- $80 \%+$ more than quadrupled and went from 3 to 13 !
- $90 \%+$ rose from 3 to 5
- The average grade of Year3 saw a steady increase:
- 65.59\% in T1
- 75.32\% in T2
- 76.31\% in T3


## Star performers

- Niyonkuru increased his grades by $28 \%$ and went from having $73 \%$ in the $1^{\text {st }}$ term to having $94 \%$ in the 3rd term, making him one of the top 3 in his class
- Niyonshuti also had a sharp increase in his grades, going from 64\% in the $1^{\text {st }}$ term, $79 \%$ in $2^{\text {nd }}$ term and $89 \% 3^{\text {rd }}$ term
- Bucyensenge Latifa also saw a great increase in her grades and went from having $77 \% 1^{\text {st }}$ term, $87 \%$ in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ term and $90 \%$ in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ term. She also went from being $5^{\text {th }}$ in her class to being 1st in both the $2^{\text {nd }}$ and third term!


## Year 4 highlights

- This class has the brightest students with a high class average vs other classes with $54 \%$ of pupils achieving a $70 \%+$ grade in the $1^{\text {st }}$ Term. This sharply increased to $88 \%$ of pupils by the $3^{\text {rd }}$ term
- By $3^{\text {rd }}$ Term, the number of pupils who had
- $70 \%+$ had risen from 14 to 23
- $80 \%+$ rose from 9 to 14
- $90 \%+$ also remained steady at 2


The average grade of Year4 saw a steady increase:

- $72.65 \%$ in T1
- $73.97 \%$ in T2
- $80.71 \%$ in T3


## Star performers

- Dukunduwera Wivine increased her grades by 22\% and went from having $81 \%$ in the $1^{\text {st }}$ term to having $99 \%$ in the 3rd term, making her top of her class
- Uwase Divine had a sharp increase in her grades, going from 59\% in the $1^{\text {st }}$ term to $85 \% 3^{\text {rd }}$ term. She went from being $8^{\text {th }}$ in her class to being in the top 3
- Uwiragiye Yvonne went from having 81\% in the 1st term and achieved $94 \%$ in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ term. She also went from being $3^{\text {rd }}$ in her class to claiming the $1^{\text {st }}$ spot
- Umugwaneza went from having 65\% in the $1^{\text {st }}$ term to achieving $86 \%$ in the third term. We went from being $6^{\text {th }}$ in her class to being $3 r d$


## Year 5 highlights



- In line with other classes, Year 5 also saw a steady increase in the number of students increasing their grades as well as the average grade increasing by $16 \%$ (Term 1 vs Term 3)
- By $3^{\text {rd }}$ Term, the number of pupils who had
- $70 \%+$ had risen from 9 to 14
- $80 \%+$ rose from 3 to 8
- $90 \%+$ went from 0 to 1

## Star performers

- Ndagijimana Emmanuel went from having $60 \%$ grade in the $1^{\text {st }}$ term to achieving $90 \%$ in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ term. He went from being $9^{\text {th }}$ in his class to being in the top 3!
- Shingiro Ngabo - very bright pupil, consistently first in his class. He sharply increased his grade from $85 \%$ in the $1^{\text {st }}$ term to $98 \%$ in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ term!
- Mukandayisenga Germaine also has consistently been $2^{\text {nd }}$ in her class. She also increased her grades from $70 \%$ in the $1^{\text {st }}$ term to $85 \%$ in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ term
